

What do I do if I want to request a study hall?

Study halls are not guaranteed. Students must be using their time wisely towards homework, studying and work completion. If you desire a study hall, circle the "Tutoring Practicum, IDLA, CWI, Internship" option and WRITE next to it "study hall".

What if two or more classes conflict in one period that I want to take?

Sometimes you need to make tough decisions. Obviously, first and foremost, if you are a future senior, any requirements for graduation need to be scheduled first before electives. For all students, core classes should take priority over electives. However, there are some instances where you can take a similar class from CWI or IDLA with approval. For most students though, it is about making the choice for one elective over another, or the core class over the elective class, knowing that you will have more years to take the other class that is in conflict.

I want to TA, but I do not have a preference of teachers, do I need a signature?

If you are OKAY with getting assigned to any teacher or TA position, you do not need a teacher's signature, but you need to write "any teacher is acceptable" or "any Elementary teacher is acceptable" or any "MS/HS teacher is acceptable". Before the beginning of next year, we will then pass out a list of students available for TA to teachers and they may designate you as their TA.

How do I register for CWI classes?

- 1. What classes do you need or desire? Determine that first. Then, figure out your school schedule so you know what times you have available for CWI classes. You need to fill out a [PAPER registration form](#) for online or campus CWI classes.*
- 2. If you have a CWI account already created, go in to your account under "Plan and Register". This is where you will find the MOST current data for the number of seats available in classes. You can enter the name of the class in the search bar at the top. MAKE SURE you look at the term on the left hand side of the screen and that it says Summer 2018. IF you don't have access to your account, you can view a pdf version of scheduled classes. Just know that this [class schedule](#) is not as up-to-date.*
- 3. The first day for registration for fall semester is APRIL 16th.*

How do I register for IDLA classes?

- 1. First, determine what class you would like to register for. You can go to www.idahodigitalllearning.org and get in-depth course information about each class. [Current class list](#)*
- 2. Complete an [enrollment form](#) and give to Mrs. Clark in the main office.*
- 3. Fall registration is NOW OPEN.*

Independent Art, what periods can I take that class?

Independent Art can be taken during any class period that Ms. Vance has an Art class or Spanish class scheduled. You must be motivated to create an art portfolio and complete [an application](#) for this class. This class is NOT for first year art students, and preferably third year art students; however, second year art students can apply.

What if I want to do the Technology class in period 1A, but have a conflict?

You can choose to work on this technology class independently fifth period with Mrs. Warr.

I want to take Spanish 2 (DC), do we still offer the class?

We no longer offer Spanish 2 (DC). Remember that if you took high school Spanish, your second year of Spanish would be Spanish 1 (DC) that we do offer. If you took Spanish 1 (DC) with Ms. Vance, then you will

need to take Spanish 2 (DC) through CWI or IDLA. If you take it online, you can sit in Ms. Vance's Spanish class at Vision and she will assist you as needed through your course. Thank you, Ms. Vance!

I am pursuing my AA. Can I take all of my classes at CWI? How many classes per semester do I have to take?

1. *Each student needs to take at least ONE class at Vision. Many students choose this class to be their math class taken as a senior, but it can be any class other than Advisory. Also, if a student is spending the majority of his or her day at CWI, s/he will need to plan on attending Advisory either on "A" days, "B" days-- or at minimum, each Friday.*
2. *Students need to take at least SIX high school credits per semester.*
 - a. *CWI classes that are 1-3 college credits = 1 HS credit; CWI classes that are 4-5 college credits = 2 HS credits. If a CWI class is taken outside of school hours, the school schedule will be adjusted to accommodate the student's attendance at a later time or weekend time and be represented within the school schedule as "CWI Class: Offsite". This means students do NOT need to be at the high school during that period; or, if they are, they are expected to be using the time for studying/completing work for the CWI class.*
 - b. *Students not taking college classes can also only take six high school credits per semester by utilizing open periods. Like study halls, open periods are NO credit classes.*
3. *For students attending classes at CWI, a ["College On-Campus Agreement"](#) form is required.*

I would like an honors diploma, but do not want to take Western Civilization for my two extra social science credits. What other courses may I take?

Vision does not offer any other in-person courses that will suffice for the two elective social science credits. However, students can take online social science courses from IDLA or CWI college GEM 6 social science courses such as: geography, anthropology, world history, Intro to Law & Justice, Military War History, psychology, sociology, etc.
